Dear unit member,

It was great to see you again a few weeks ago and you were all so organised and enthusiastic about the days activities – you really are a unit to be proud of. For our next meeting in Bulwell please make sure you arrive in your uniform top, two neckers and name tag as usual. However we will be continuing painting the mess tents sides so please bring clothes you are happy to get dirty or an apron or similar to protect your clothing. We will also be designing our patrol flags to be displayed at the Jamboree – remember there is a prize for the best one so get your thinking caps on.

Enclosed with this letter is a permission to camp form for our next camp in March. Please could you bring this to the February meeting or post it to Nate, his address on the form as he is in charge of this camp. We must have this before the camp in March. Please complete it even if no details have changed since last time.

As we said at the last meeting please can you apply for an European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) if you do not already have one. This is to get medical treatment in the EEA and Switzerland. (E111's are now invalid.) Over 16's need their own card but under 16's will need parent/s to register and then add you under the dependents section. You can get a card online at [www.dh.gov.uk/travellers](http://www.dh.gov.uk/travellers), or phone 0845 6062030, or from the Post Office. There is no charge and they last for five years. I renewed mine earlier this month and it took a week to be sent through. They can be renewed six months before the expiry date. We will be asking for photocopies of the EHIC cards in May, so please apply for one before then. If you already have one please check it is in date for the Jamboree.

You have also been given unit badges to sell for £2 each. Please bring in the money for these as you collect it in so it can be paid into our account and pay off some of our debts! Thanks to those who have already sold badges and handed in the money. If you have badges you cannot sell please return them so we can pass them onto other unit members who would like more.

The next meeting is Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> February at Bulwell TA Centre, Hucknall Lane, Bulwell, NG6 8AQ, 10am-4pm. Please bring a packed lunch as you will not be able to go off site. Thank you to Alisha's parents who organised this meeting place and supplied the following directions;

**Directions from junction 26, M1.**

From the M1 at junction 26, at the roundabout take the exit to A610 Nottingham, following the A6002. At the next roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit onto A6002 Bulwell. At the next roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit to A6002, (signposted Hucknall A610). At the roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit onto the A6002, B682. At the end of the road (T junction), second set of traffic lights turn right onto Hucknall Lane – B682, Bulwell town centre. 300m on the right (Big Green Gun) this is Bulwell TA Centre.

### **Directions from Mansfield**

Follow the A60 south. At traffic signals by Ravenshead continue on the A60 Nottingham. Turn right onto Blidworth Way, B683, Linby. At cross roads go straight on onto Moor Lane, B683 towards Bestwood, Hucknall. At traffic signals turn right onto the A611, signposted M1, Matlock, A6002. At mini roundabout turn left onto the A6002. At traffic signals continue forward onto Hucknall Lane. Morrisons will be on your left, straight on at lights and then 300m on your right is Bulwell TA Centre.
