

## Monopoly Live

**Friday 9<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2010**

This is a competition, run by Nottinghamshire Scouts, which is open to all Explorer Scouts.

Teams of 5 Explorers have 8 hours to visit and photograph themselves at various locations around Nottinghamshire, making use of the superb Tram and Bus Network, just like a live game of Monopoly.

The competition is limited to 50 teams. Any other teams will be placed onto a sequential waiting list in the very unlikely event of a team "dropping out".

Teams to arrive at the Robin Hood Scout Camp, Rickets Lane, Blidworth, near Mansfield, Notts NG21 0NF (Grid Ref: SK120:565 560). They must be checked in, set up, fed and ready for briefing which will take place at 9.00pm on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> July 2010.

Each Team will need to arrange your own Nights Away Notification and home contact or "intouch" contact procedure. A copy of the NAN form must be presented with the health forms on arrival at the event.

- Tent accommodation for your team
- 1<sup>st</sup> Aid Kit
- Sleeping kit
- Clothing
- Day bag
- Water Proofs
- Digital Camera with a removable, empty memory card
- Uniform

After arrival on Friday night, you will have some supper and games to get to know your fellow competitors.

Following Saturday's breakfast teams will be issued with a packed lunch and taken to a local tram station to commence the competition. Each team will have exactly 8 hours to complete as much of the competition as possible and to arrive back at their starting point.

Scout neckers and an event t-shirt will be worn whilst out and about during the competition.

Each team will use their digital camera to take a photo of themselves at the locations.

On completion of the competition, teams will be returned to Robin Hood Scout Camp to submit their photos and results sheet.

There will then be an evening meal and more activities.

Following Sunday breakfast, winners will be announced and prizes awarded. Teams are then free to leave the Scout Camp after checking-out at approximately 10am.

All for a fee of £30 per Explorer and £20 per Leader.
